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Report on TRASH TALK - 31/03/2021

With energy and enthusiasm on the high, on Friday-Saturday, we embarked to Hootgalli, Hunsur Road, to spread awareness to the citizens of Hootgalli about Waste Segregation. Doors were knocked on, conversations were held and smiles were exchanged. After months of online campaigns, going and reaching out to the people personally had an entirely different level of satisfaction. Seeing irresponsible disposal of trash on roads and pavements inspired us to take the topic of 'Waste segregation' as our central theme.

With masks on and maintaining a safe distance at all times, we had interesting and interactive discussions with the residents about the necessity of waste segregation. Not only did we spread awareness about this subject but we were also thrilled to hear their heartfelt stories. We were delighted to know that a majority of the residents already made efficient use of their wet waste through composting. An elderly couple told us about their routine composting practice and growing a beautiful garden right behind their lovely home.

We gave them some additional tips on how to enhance their composting techniques and they were thrilled with our suggestions and guaranteed to give them a try. Some residents even took the initiative to separate their waste by hand and send their dry waste to local corporations. However, they were concerned about the efficiency of these corporations in disposing of dry waste properly. We promised them that we would contact the corporations in sorting out this problem. Apart from this, another grandmother told us about her tradition of customising her old blouse pieces into beautiful hand-made cloth bags.

Concepts of waste segregation and re-usability have always been an integral part of Indian culture and we sought out to revive those back by creating conversations. We knew that if we created awareness in a personal/intimate manner, it could bring about

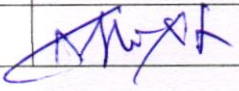

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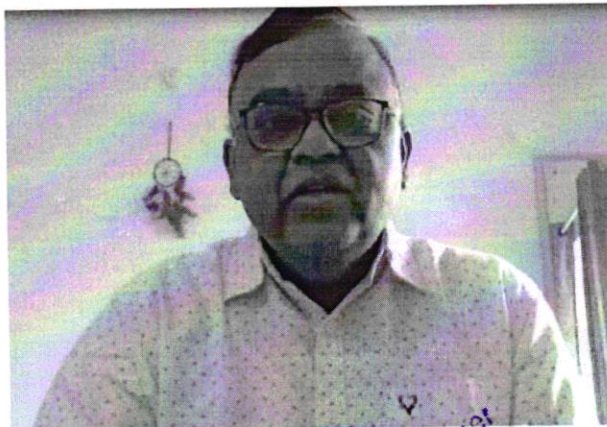


Celebration of "World Environment Day" on June 5th 2021

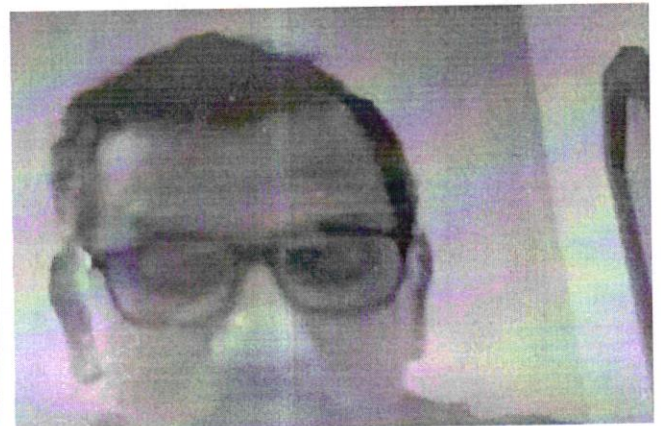

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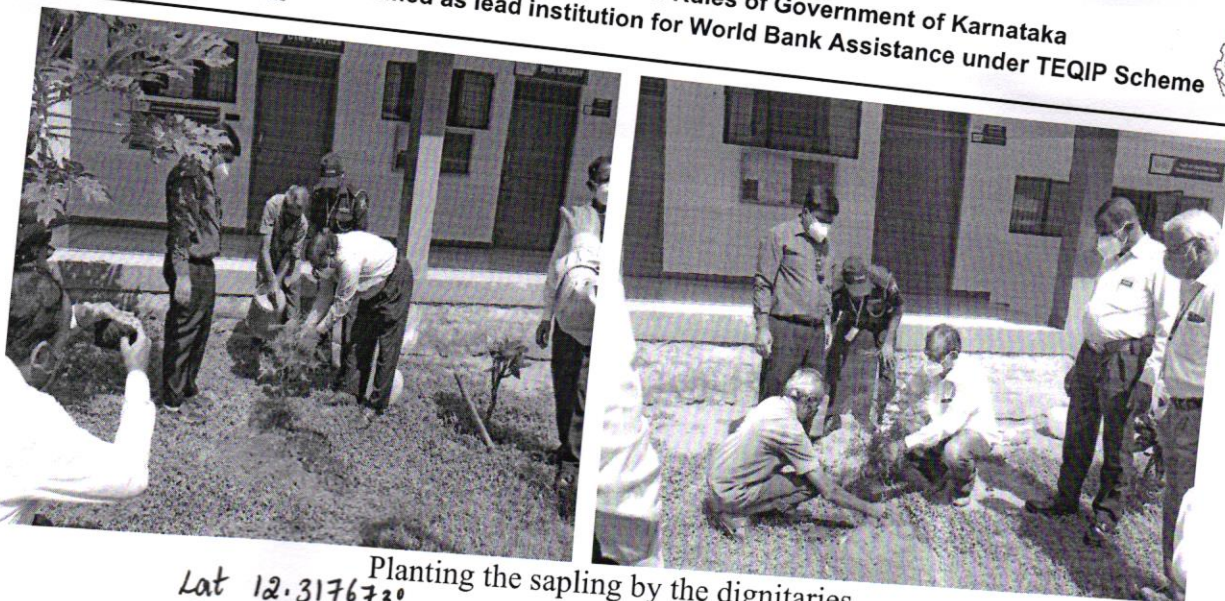
