Total number of teams participated: 29

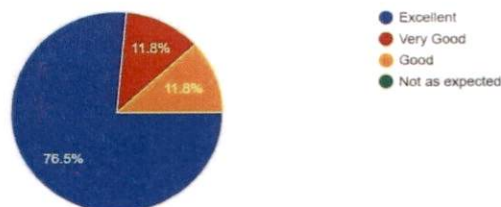

How was your overall experience of the event

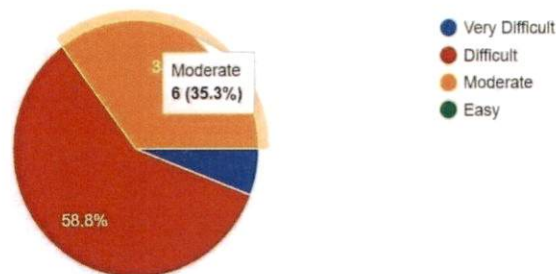

What was the level of questions

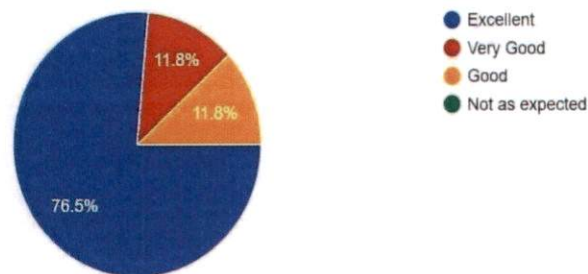

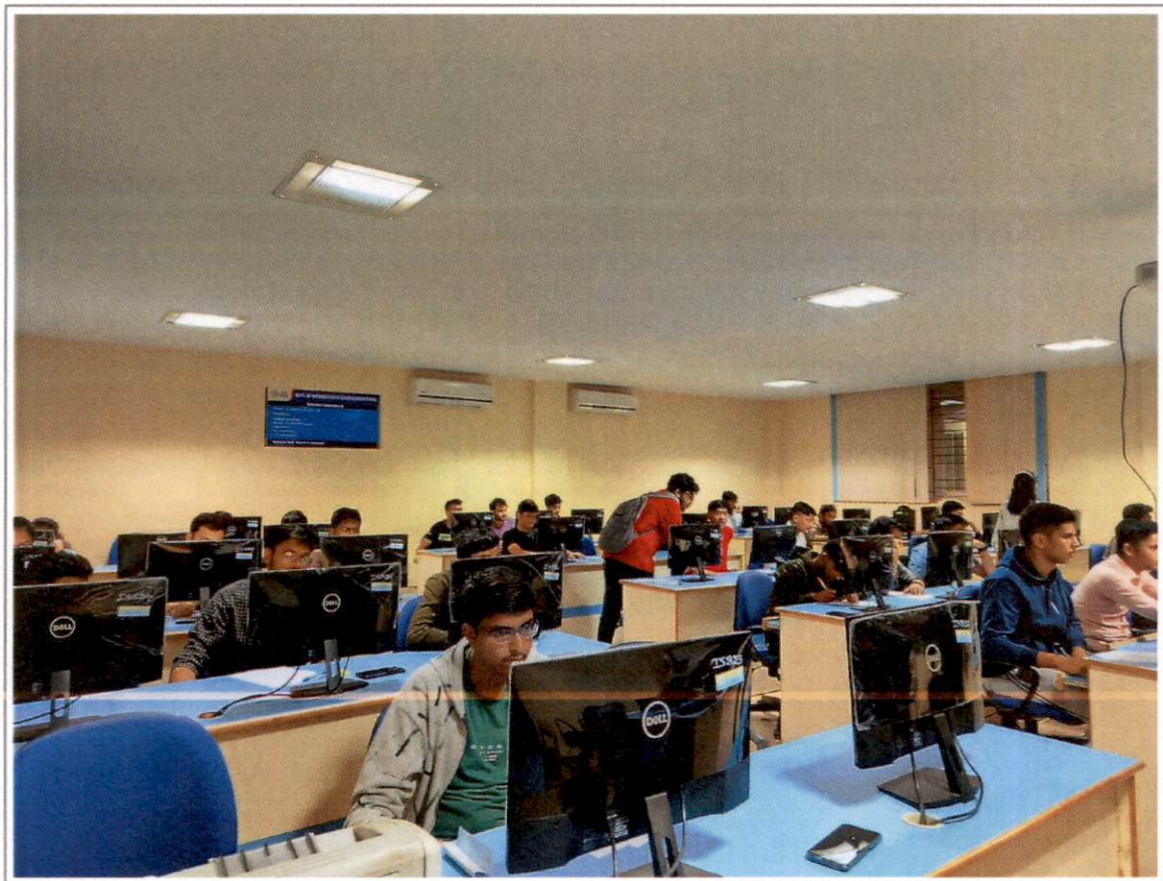

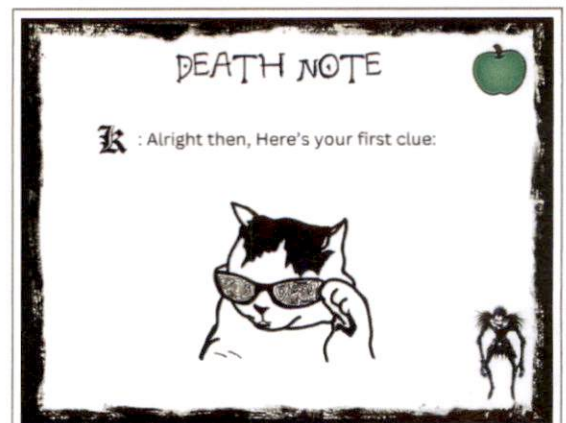
